Dr. Dan Columbus is a Research Scientist in nutrition at the Prairie Swine Centre and Adjunct Professor in the Department of Animal and Poultry Science at the University of Saskatchewan. His research focuses on the impact of health on nutrient utilization and requirements, early-life nutrition and development, and factors affecting nutrient utilization. He has served as Western Director for the Canadian Society of Animal Science and as an Associate Editor for the Canadian Journal of Animal Science. He also co-hosts the Swine it Podcast Show Canada. Dr. Columbus is involved in both undergraduate and graduate teaching and mentorship. He has published more than 50 peer-reviewed scientific publications, 100 conference abstracts and papers, and 40 industry publications. He has also given more than 60 presentations and interviews. He was the 2019 recipient of the Canadian Society of Animal Science Young Scientist Award and the 2021 Sask Pork Award of Distinction for Excellence in Production Research.
